Production Acceptance

- Production over .9 mt/ac (40 bushels) will be bought at Bunge's discretion
- Bunge will inform producer by November 30, 2027 if there is an opportunity to buy overage



Special Event (Act of God)

- Special Event (Act of God) protection up to .9 mt/ac (40 bushels) on basis contracts for any production reconciled by October 15, 2027
- Special Event (Act of God) protection up to .25 mt/ac (11 bushels) on fixed price portion for any production reconciled by October 15, 2027
- Allows risk free forward pricing opportunities



Program Advantages

- Earn more revenue per acre with exclusive contract premiums for substantial returns
- Mitigate risk that comes with fluctuating canola export markets

Delivery

- On-farm pickup options
- Choose from the available delivery periods when contracting through one or more GPA contracts
- Delivery commitments must be spread across available delivery periods, with no more than 25% of production in any one given window
